

RECOVERY TIME **Shockwaves** are administered from outside the body to break up the stone.

Non-infectious stones (<15mm)

Unlikely

- Non-invasive
- May require repeat procedures

None

1 - 2 days

8 days\*

A scope and fibre is inserted into the ureter to break up stones with a laser.

Non-infectious stones (<20mm)

Likely

- Minimally invasive
- Stent discomfort

1 - 2 days

5 - 7 days

15 days\*

A **cut** is made on the lower back to access the kidney and remove the stone.

Infectious & non-infectious stones (>20mm)

Likely

- Invasive
- Stent and possible nephrostomy tube discomfort

1 - 2 days

7 - 14 days

15 days\*
